



## Young Engineer of the Year Recognition

The Structural Engineers Association of Ohio (SEAO) is honored to offer Young Engineer of the Year recognition to highlight the professional contributions of its younger members. This recognition may be awarded annually to SEAO members who are 35 years of age or younger on or before March 31 in the year of nomination.

### **Nominee Criteria:**

- Outstanding service and commitment to the profession and association
- Involved with the mentoring and development of younger members
- Technical and ethical competence
- 35 years of age or younger on or before March 31 in the year of nomination

### **Young Engineer of the Year Recognition:**

This shall be presented annually if, and when, enough suitable candidates are available. No more than one recipient will be named in each year, and no recipient may be awarded this recognition more than once. Recognition shall consist of a plaque with the name of the recipient and the recognition circumstances, and complimentary registration to the Annual Conference.

### **Selection Process:**

Nominations shall be submitted the Recognition Committee by close of business on March 31. The Recognition Committee will submit its recommendation to the SEAO Board of Directors for final vote and approval. The recipient will be notified in May. Meritorious nominees not selected may be considered the following year, should the nominee remain eligible. Active members of the Recognition Committee are not eligible for this award.
